Vernon Public Schools' Calendar: The Vernon Board of Education will be discussing the school calendar at the next Board of Education Meeting; however, I do not expect that they will be making any decisions about changing the calendar until the spring after the winter season has ended. As of right now, we have one day for Hurricane Irene to make up and five days for Storm Alfred (the sixth day off for Storm Alfred is being made up on Friday, November 11th) which will all be made up at the end of the school year. So, as of today, the last day of school will be Wednesday, June 20, 2012.
