Citizens' Advisory Committees to the Board of Education

The Board of Education endorses appropriate ad hoc advisory committees for various district programs and activities. When it establishes a committee, the Board shall provide guidelines for membership and delineate the committee's responsibilities, authority, and meeting requirements pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act.

With the approval of the Board, the chairperson of any board committee may appoint one or more advisors. The advisors shall be considered to be regular members of the specific committee except for the right to vote.
