## Tuition Fees

The Vernon Board of Education will permit students from other school districts to attend local schools when they can be accommodated in existing classes. The principal is to screen the student for placement and acceptance. The students or their sending district shall pay a tuition fee to be established annually by the board. The tuition fee may be adjusted as changes in costs indicate, unless a multiple year agreement to provide educational accommodations is entered into with another board of education. Reasonable efforts will be made to notify non-resident students of any pending changes in agreements.

A Rockville High School student who moves out of district after completion of the junior year may request to complete their senior year at Rockville High School without payment of tuition. A written request by parent/guardian must be submitted to the high school principal. Such request requires the approval of both the high school principal and the superintendent of schools. Transportation is the responsibility of the parent.

The Board shall establish a tuition rate for out-of-district students attending the vocational agricultural program that is in conformity with section 10-65 of the general statutes.
