Safety shall be a major component of the instructional plan of the district schools through educational programs such as, but not limited to traffic and pedestrian safety, driver education, fire prevention, emergency procedures, etc., appropriately geared to students at different grade levels.

The Superintendent of schools shall have overall responsibility for district's safety program, and each building administrator shall be responsible for the supervision of a safety program for his/her school.

General areas of emphasis shall include, but not be limited to:

1. in-service training;
2. accident record-keeping;
3. facilities inspection;
4. driver and vehicle safety programs;
5. fire prevention;
6. emergency procedures and traffic safety problems relevant to students and employees.
