Principals and teachers shall try to resolve student learning problems within the school setting before recommending a tutor or other outside professional help. Through maintaining a high quality instructional staff and providing a rich and varied curriculum, the need for individual tutoring will be minimized.

Should tutoring be recommended in exceptional cases, the superintendent shall establish rules to prevent conflicts of interest.

Tutors used by the school system will be drawn from the substitute list or the school staff. Exceptions may be made in unique cases as approved by the Central Office.

Evaluation of Tutors

The principal or a designee will evaluate the performance of tutors in order to maintain an updated list of effective personnel.
