## Tutoring

5114.1

**Instruction at alternative sites:** As defined by statute, the Superintendent is empowered to arrange for tutoring of children unable to attend school for health reasons or as the result of an expulsion.

Tutoring for health reasons is arranged following receipt of a statement from the pupil's physician. Five hours per week shall be considered a minimum of home instruction.

The following conditions must be met:

A quiet place conducive to study should be provided for the tutoring session.

A parent or other adult must be present in the home during the tutoring session.

Tutoring following expulsion may be in the home of the student or at some alternate location approved by the Superintendent. In either situation, a parent or other adult must be present.
