Core Curriculum Areas

The Vernon Board of Education meets state required curriculum standards and may offer courses in addition to those requirements. State statutes require course offerings in at least the following subject matter:

1. The arts;
2. Career education;
3. Consumer education;
4. Health and safety, including, but not limited to, human growth and development, nutrition, first aid, disease prevention, community and consumer health, physical, mental and emotional health including youth suicide prevention, substance abuse prevention, general safety, and accident prevention;
5. Language arts, including reading, writing, grammar, speaking and spelling;
6. Mathematics;
7. Physical education;
8. Science;
9. Social studies, including, but not limited to, citizenship, economics, geography, government and history;
10. At least on the secondary level, one or more foreign languages and vocational education.
